Reconciliation and Visit from Dresden 3-8 July 2026

Some of you will remember that I have been involved with a link with churches in Dresden for many years and a couple of you have been on a visit there with me in the past while others have met our visitors on occasions. This is linked to the Community of the Cross of Nails at Coventry Cathedral and started out thinking about reconciliation between us and the Germans following the Second World War. It has now developed into a much deeper link and friendships supporting each other through all the changes in the world in the last thirty years. The main link is with St John's in Kenilworth, but I still get involved and link with our church as well. Our next visit from the Evangelical-Lutheran Church at Hosterwitz in Dresden is on 3-8 July this year.

If you are interested in getting involved there are several opportunities for you to join us. Most of them speak good English, but it does give you a chance to practice your German, if you wish. They are a very interesting group of people to talk to as well as being interested in what we have to say.
